Lack of a National Currency

- 1- CREATED INFLATION (CAUSE AMOUNT OF MONEY COULD NOT BE REGULATED)
- 2- DISCOURAGED TRADE BETWEEN STATE - DIFFICULT TO DETERMINE VALUE
- CONGRESS'S INABILITY TO TAX
- 1- COULD NOT PAY DEBTS
- 2- COULD NOT USE TAXES TO CONTROL TRADE & STIMULATE DOMESTIC BUSINESSES

Congress's inability to regulate trade

- 1- MARKETS FLOODED W/ FOREIGN GOODS, BRITISH MANUFACTURED GOODS WITH SUPPLIES AM. BUSINESS
- 2- AM. RAW MATERIALS DIFFICULT TO SELL ON INTERNATIONAL MARKET

Lack of a national military

- 1- COULD NOT ENFORCE TREATIES (E.G. ARMY STILL ON WESTERN LANDS)
- 2- COULD NOT DEFEND USE OF MISSISSIPPI RIVER. (SPANISH)
- 3- COULD NOT CONTROL DOMESTIC DISPUTES (SOUTH'S REBELLION)

Lack of national executive and judicial branches

- 1- COULD NOT ENFORCE OR INTERPRET NATIONAL LAW IN THE DIFFERENT STATES

- could not pay nations bills & debts
- could not supply military
- could not build roads that were needed
- could not pay loans - not able to pay back

CONGRESS CAN'T FIX STATES -

- states often changed treaties on other states
- change trade issues
- foreign nations did not trust value of currency would not trade w/ us
- brit floods market w/ tax-resistant items hurtling
- vis. business

UNREGULATED TRADE -

- too much state power
- laws differ between states
- some states had own power there was little national unity
- fed gov't lacked power to fix nat'l problems
